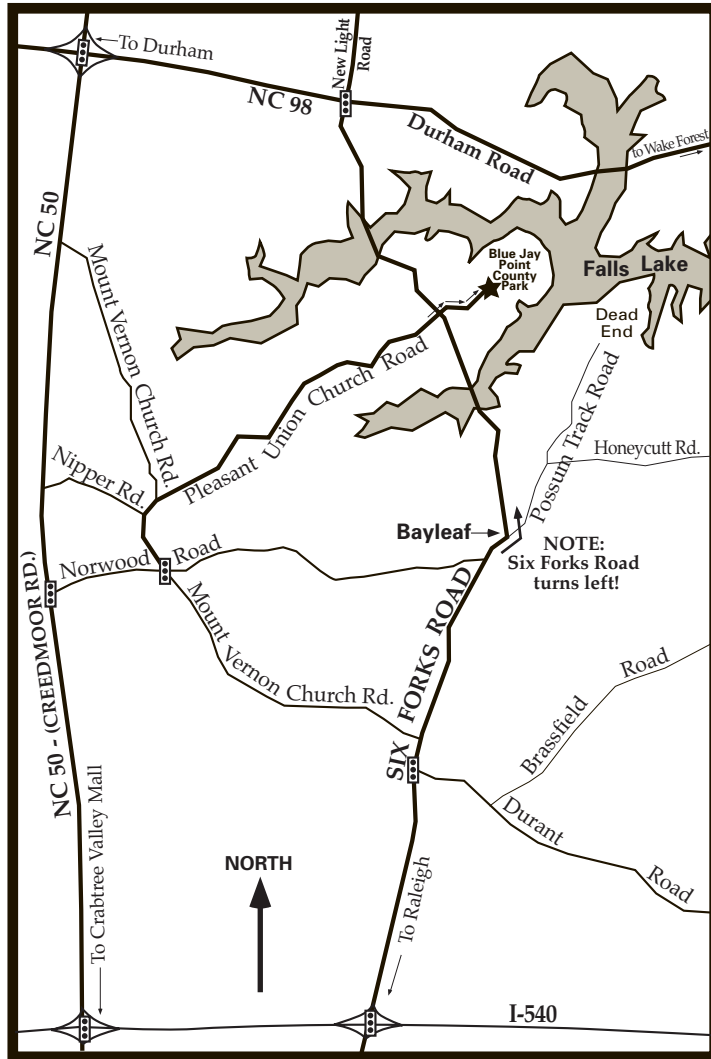


BLUE JAY POINT COUNTY PARK

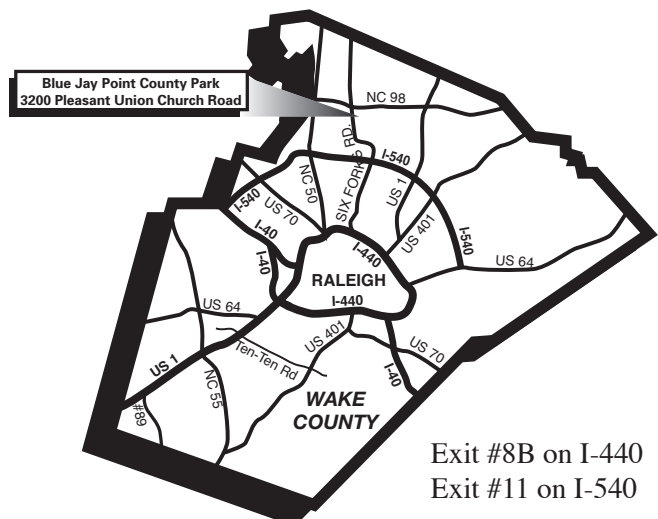
Vicinity Map (Not Drawn to Scale)

Blue Jay Point is located on Pleasant Union Church Road approximately nine miles north of the I-440 beltline. When taking Six Forks Road north, remember to turn left at the Bayleaf water tower in order to stay on Six Forks Road! (2.5 miles after I-540)

Exit #11 on I-540

– Directions to BJP –

There are 4 sets of directions below, please read the one that corresponds to your starting point:

From East and Southeast - I-440 Outer or I-540W (and I-40W): Raleigh, Knightdale, Zebulon, Fayetteville, Wilmington, Rocky Mount, Wilson

- Take Hwy. I-440 Outer or I-540 West.
- Exit onto Six Forks Rd., heading NORTH, out of Raleigh
- Continue on Six Forks Rd., approx. 2.5 mi. after I-540.
- Now there should be a sign for Hwy-98 and a Citgo gas station on the right and the Bay Leaf Volunteer Fire Station and water tower on the left. At this point, take a physical LEFT turn onto Six Forks Rd. (from Six Forks Rd.). If you had continued straight, you would have been on Possum Track Rd.
- Continue to follow Six Forks Rd. across one bridge over the Lake. At the next full street intersection, take a RIGHT onto Pleasant Union Church Rd.
- This road will take you into the park.

From West and Southwest – I-440 Inner or I-540E (and I-40E): Raleigh, Cary, Durham, Greensboro, Winston Salem, Charlotte

- Take Hwy. I-440 Inner or I-540 East.
- Exit onto Six Forks Rd., heading NORTH, out of Raleigh
- Continue on Six Forks Rd., approx. 2.5 mi. after I-540.
- Now there should be a sign for Hwy-98 and a Citgo gas station on the right and the Bay Leaf Volunteer Fire Station and water tower on the left. At this point, take a physical LEFT turn onto Six Forks Rd. (from Six Forks Rd.). If you had continued straight, you would have been on Possum Track Rd.
- Continue to follow Six Forks Rd. across one bridge over the Lake. At the next full street intersection, take a RIGHT onto Pleasant Union Church Rd.
- This road will take you into the park.

From Northeast - Hwy-98W: Wake Forest

- Take Hwy-98W/Durham Rd. heading WEST toward Durham.
- Turn LEFT at the light onto Six Forks Rd. (to the right, the road is called New Light Rd.)
- Go across one bridge over the Lake and continue to the top of the next hill. At the top of the hill is a full street intersection. Take a LEFT here onto Pleasant Union Church Rd.
- This road will take you into the park.

From Northwest - I-85N: Durham

- Take I-85N/Hwy-70E east towards Raleigh/Wake Forest
- Take the exit after Hwy-55/Avondale Rd. onto Hwy-70E, towards the airport
- Exit off of Hwy-70E onto Hwy-98E/Wake Forest Highway.
- After crossing Hwy-50/Creedmoor Rd. (big intersection in the middle of nowhere), take a RIGHT at the next light onto Six Forks Rd. This street is labeled New Light Rd. on the left and Six Forks Rd. on the right.
- Go across one bridge over the Lake and continue to the top of the next hill. At the top of the hill is a full street intersection. Take a LEFT here onto Pleasant Union Church Rd.
- This road will take you into the park.
